CAMP LANEY is a camp for boys in Mentone, Alabama, to which our whole congregation goes for 2 fun-filled days for all ages.

Each family has the use of a rustic cabin and a modern bathroom for themselves.

So much to do: ropes course, zip line, river with canoes, swimming pool, full size gym, food and fellowship at tables in the dining hall, a Lodge with rocking chairs, hiking, whatever you want to do.

We go on Saturday morning, September 9<sup>th</sup> (90 minutes from Calhoun), and share for lunch the foods we bring with Us. After that, through lunch on Sunday, Camp Laney provides the food.

The cost is \$65.00 per person. **WE WANT EVERYONE** to go.
